### ADDRESS BY THE CHAIRMAN

The Chairman welcomed all the members of the Governing Council and sought for their co-operation in all the activities. On a motion sponsored by the chairman, the following resolutions were adopted by the Governing Council.

The following points were discussed:

#### Admission:

1. Admission Strategy for the academic year 2018-19 was proposed for Tamilnadu and Telugu Minority students was discussed.

2. To conduct free Technical Summer training for Plus Two rural students through 56 Technical Clubs.

3. To conduct Motivational Talk for Plus Twooppers during the month of January 2018.

4. To Conduct DST sponsored Inspire Programme for top two meritorious students from schools located at Chennai, Thiruvallur and Kanchipuram.

5. To conduct Prayoga 2017 - Science Projects exhibition for school students.

6. Surrender of 10% seats in Civil and Mechanical departments.

### Academics:

1. To reopen the college for the second year students on 12<sup>th</sup> June 2017 and for the Third year and Final Year Students on 19<sup>th</sup> June 2017.

2. Academic Schedule for the odd semester to be decided.
