Information to Candidates

- Reservation for BC, BC Muslim, MBC, SC, SC(Arunthathiyars) and ST is applicable to the candidates belonging to Tamil Nadu only.
- Candidates, who do not produce the original Permanent Community Certificate(either card or electronic form / digitally signed e-certificate) will be treated under **"open competition"** only.
- Other State candidates are eligible for **"open competition"** only.
- Candidates have to bring either cash or a demand draft for Rs.5300/- (Rs.1150/- in the case of SC/SCA/ST candidates belonging to Tamil Nadu) drawn in favour of **"The Secretary, Tamil Nadu Common Admissions, Anna University,"** payable at Chennai (obtained not earlier than 24.08.2019). This amount includes a non-refundable counselling fee of Rs.300/-(Rs.150/- in the case of SC/SCA/ST candidates belonging to Tamil Nadu).
- Candidates who do not bring this call letter along with all the original certificates and the cash or demand draft will not be permitted for counselling.
- This communication is based on the information furnished by the candidate in the application. Any changes - found during verification of originals or later - are subject to change of rank/eligibility.
- **More number of candidates than the actual seats available have been called for counselling.Candidates will be offered admission depending upon the seats available, eligibility, merit / rank based on the marks obtained in TANCET 2019 conducted by Anna University in the appropriate discipline of Engineering/Technology and rule of reservation. Other candidates cannot claim any right for admission.**
- **Candidates are advised to check the availability of seats in the courses/colleges of their choice in Anna University website www.annauniv.edu/tanca2019 and attend the Counselling.**



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General Instructions

1. The college and course of study will be allotted as per rank, communal and other reservations and / or the availability of seats during counselling. The candidate is directed to attend the counselling on the date and time indicated above at his/her own cost, with all original certificates.
2. If a candidate has deposited all the original certificates in an institution where he/she has already been admitted, a bonafide certificate from the Head of the Institution should be brought to that effect. In such cases only, attested copies of certificates will be accepted. Such candidates are advised not to get the Transfer Certificate from that institution before getting allotment. However, Original allotment order will be withheld till all the original certificates are produced for verification.
3. Selection of the college and course of study is the sole responsibility of the candidate. Choice once made is final and cannot be changed.
4. If the candidate does not report for admission as per the allotment order, he/she has to forfeit the seat allotted and cannot claim the seat later.
5. The courses and intake in colleges indicated in "Information about Colleges" online brochure are subject to change. Candidates are advised to check at the Counselling Centre or in the website: www.annauniv.edu/tanca2019 for approved courses and sanctioned intake.
6. The Candidates are advised to ascertain the fee structure of the colleges before opting for the seat.
7. Allotted candidates will be given the allotment order and a receipt for Rs.5000/- (Rs.1000/- in the case of SC/SCA/ST candidates belonging to Tamil Nadu). Thereafter the candidates have to pay the remaining fees in the college selected at the time of admission on the date specified in the allotment order.
8. Candidates under sponsored category should produce the relieving order from their organisation at the time of admission.

- 1 The Management Aptitude Test (MAT) is designed to measure the aptitude of a candidate for pursuing management education and should be used only for this purpose.
- 2 MAT is administered in five sections-Language Comprehension, Mathematical Skills, Data Analysis & Sufficiency, Intelligence & Critical Reasoning and Indian & Global Environment-each section testing a different ability relevant for management education.
- 3 All MAT administrations necessarily have different questions. Thus one administration may be slightly more difficult or less difficult than another. Scaling has been used to take care of these differences.
- 4 The scaled scores reported are standardised scores for respective sections. These scores are reported on a scale of 0 to 100. Extreme scores (below 15 or above 85) are rare.
- 5 The percentile below column indicates the percentage of candidates in the test who scores below that of the candidate in the section.
- 6 The Composite score is an overall scaled score based on the first four sections of MAT. This is reported on a scale of 199 to 801.
- 7 The percentile below for the Composite Score represents the percentage of candidates whose composite scores are below the candidate's. The composite score has a validity period of one year.
- 8 All scores and percentile below figures are reported after rounding off to the nearest whole number.



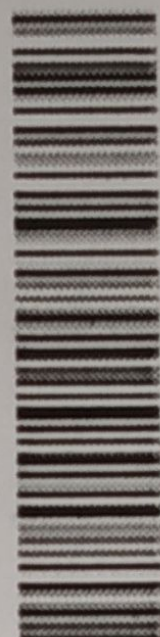


