The following are the changes incorporated in Regulations 2024 as per the recommendations / suggestions by the Academic Council Members:

OBJECTIVES

- To shift focus from the teacher centric to student centric education.
- To allow students to choose inter-disciplinary, intra-disciplinary and skill oriented courses (even from other disciplines according to their learning needs, interests and aptitude) to provide more flexibility.
- **P2RIDE** Project intensive activities.
- To make education broad-based and at par with global standards
- To help students earn credits by choosing unique combination of courses.
- To offer flexibility for students to get **international exposure** by completing a course at world class institutions facilitating the transfer of credits earned.
- To provide necessary flexibility to students to gain the vital life skills.
- To equip students to keep abreast of industrial requirements and societal needs.
- Clause 4.2 For the students who complete the mandatory course satisfying the attendance requirements the title of the mandatory courses will be mentioned in Grade Sheet.
- Clause 4.2.1 on Induction Programme amended and added.
- Clause 4.5 Industrial Training/Internship amended and improved.

- Clause 4.8 comprising of clauses 4.8.1 and 4.8.2, Online Courses for expanded with additional details. 3 credits, 3 Online courses permitted for drop.
- Clause 4.10 in PE/OE on courses in physical / hybrid online modes offered by reputed Universities/Institutions qualified with reference to the NIRF/QS ranking.
- Clause 4.11 Courses offered by Research Institutes/reputed companies eligibility norms added in the Clause.
- Clause 4.12 in B.E./B.Tech. Honours, Specialization amended, new features added, expanded and detailed.
- Clauses 5.4 and 5.5 on Formula for calculating of percentage of attendance, number of working days or periods for every semester included.
- Clause 6.3 Add/Drop periods refined and amended.
- Clause 14.2.1.2, Table 9, assessment norms for Practical exams introduced.
- Clause 14.2.1.3 on project work/Start up fully modified with one phase project work in the last semester for UG.
- Clause 14.7, 14.8 and 14.9 for assessment for Employability Enhancement Courses introduced.
- Clause 21.1, Table 13 and Clause 21.2 classification of degree amended.
- Clause 22 Award of degree modified.
- Clause 26.2 guided self-study courses limited for PG courses only.
- Clause 29 on Revision of Regulations, curriculum and syllabi is amended.

6. BOS Approval of Curriculum Syllabus

- Approved Curriculum and Syllabus of all Boards of Studies.
- In the next Academic Council it should be presented by the respective Chairman.
- In the Clause 4.28, Induction should not be mentioned in the Syllabus, but to be mentioned in the Regulations 2024.

- CO-PO Mapping should be included for all subjects.
- Common format should be maintained for all the syllabus.
- NPTEL references could be added after the reference books.
- Recent Text books (latest edition) should be included in the Text books and reference books.
- To seek approval from respective BOS for curriculum (4 years) and Syllabus (III & IV semester) by December 2024/January 2025.
